

# Response to Intervention (RTI) Stages

## **Step 1: Problem Identification**

- Compare benchmarks to typical child and determine whether there is a discrepancy (Example: If using DIBELS, may consider using 25<sup>th</sup> percentile or below)
- If yes, get parent involvement, receive signature, consider for SAT

## **Step 2: Problem Analysis**

- SAT team involvement
- Where is instructional mismatch?
- Gather additional information (i.e., observational data, medical, attendance, and discipline referrals)

## **Step 3: Goal Setting**

- How much should student grow?
- Determine aim line (i.e., child's baseline to goal)
- Determine time line (i.e., Apply each intervention for eight weeks)

## **Step 4: Plan Implementation**

- Determine Intervention (i.e., must be research based and with integrity (PALS, REWARDS, Sound Partners, etc.))
- Progress monitor once per week

## **Step 5: Plan Evaluation**

- Ongoing progress monitoring
